Afghan Resettlement Project

This year the Kenmore UMC Mission Team has chosen to support our Afghan Resettlement Project. One young couple, Omid, Spozhmay and their infant Asra are living in one of our apartments. They have family living in a hotel in Amherst (currently). These two families represent only a small percentage of the 450 or more Afghan's being resettled in the Buffalo area. They will require housing, transportation, food, clothing, medical care and more. Most of these re-settlers left their homeland with only the clothes on their backs, in fear of their lives. They love to tell of their homeland but made the heart-breaking decision to leave for the safety of their children and themselves. The funds from the Easter Alternative will help us support these families and others as they acclimate themselves to the Buffalo area, get jobs, and become part of the fabric that is Western New York.
